Action Plan (Class 11 → Class 12)

Class 11 (Current Year)

- Target IB predicted score: 38–42+
- Build writing portfolio (articles, blogs, excerpts from published books)
- Profile building: 1–2 internships (startup/NGO/research), debate/MUN/public speaking, school leadership.
- Begin IELTS prep; target 7.5–8 band.

Class 12 (Application Year)

- India: Apply to Ashoka, NMIMS, Symbiosis; consider CUET only if dates and syllabus align (do not rely solely on CUET)
- UK/Netherlands/Singapore: Prepare personal statement/essays, organize writing portfolio, take IELTS; apply via UCAS (UK) and direct portals (EU/SG)
- Shortlist 6–8 universities abroad balancing reach/target/safe
- Maintain grades and continue impactful extracurriculars with leadership evidence.

Admissions Positioning Strategy

Position as: "Young corporate thinker and published author with strong economic understanding and global communication skills."

- Leverage authorship and editorial leadership heavily in applications.
- Show evidence of analytical thinking via economics projects or research.
- Demonstrate leadership and initiative (clubs, publications, events)

Post-Graduation Corporate Path
